Health & Wellness Corner

Energize

Everyone needs to eat carbohydrates. They are an essential part of a healthy diet – the body's primary energy source. There are 3 main types: sugars, starches, and fiber. All carbs are not created equal. It is important to know the difference between "good carbs" and "bad carbs", which can be both simple and complex. Foods fall into those 2 categories based on their chemical makeup & what our bodies do with them. Because many foods contain one or more types of carbohydrates, it can be tricky determining what is healthy.

Simple carbs are made of easy-to-digest basic sugars — some found naturally in fruits, vegetables, and milk. Refined sources are found in baked goods, candies, and soda (not our friends). Complex carbs are found in whole grains, legumes, and starchy vegetables. They contain longer chains of sugar molecules that usually take longer for the body to use and break down; providing a more consistent amount of energy. Now, even though fruits & veggies are considered simple carbohydrates, many are rich in fiber — which changes the way their sugars are processed. This slows their digestion (just like the complex carbs), which keeps us going longer throughout the day.

So, when we make our carbohydrate choices, let's lean towards buckwheat, whole wheat flour, quinoa, brown rice, barley, corn, oats, sweet potatoes, black beans, chick peas, lentils, bananas, oranges, blueberries, beets, and apples. Read the label; if the food is higher in fiber and lower in sugar, go for it! It's likely to energize and sustain.
